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### Geography Solution To Map Reading

By map reading, the reader should be able to develop a mental map of the real-world information by processing the symbolized information shown on the map. To do this, the reader will need to derive essential information presented by the map such as distance, direction, natural and man-made features, and topographical features.

### What is Map Reading? - Geography Realm

In map reading the calculation of gradient is done by comparing the vertical interval between two places and the horizontal distance between them. Vertical Interval (V.I) is the difference in height between the two places; it can be obtained by subtracting the altitude of the lower point from the altitude of the higher point.

A neatline is the border of a map. It helps to define the edge of the map area and keep things looking organized. Cartographers may also use neatlines to define offsets, which are mini-maps depicting magnified important areas or those not within the map's boundaries.
