LLC Resolution: Everything You Need to Know

Because of this, there is no specific or required way to draft an LLC resolution. While not all states require an operating agreement, it's often beneficial for an LLC to have one. This is particularly so in the case of a multi-member LLC, since an operating agreement, much like the articles of incorporation for a corporation, provides guidelines that govern the operation and management of the LLC.

An LLC member resolution is the written record of a member vote authorizing a specific business action. Formal resolutions aren't necessary for small, everyday decisions. However, they're useful for granting authority to members to transact significant business actions, such as taking out a loan on behalf of the LLC.

A limited liability company (LLC) is created by following the statutes dictated by state law. The business must file articles of organization—also called a certificate of formation or a certificate of organization, in some states—and pay a fee with the filing office of the state where the business is located.

Unless the articles of incorporation or bylaws of the corporation specifically require a greater number, approval of the resolution by a majority of the board of directors is sufficient, so long as a quorum is present when the vote is taken. Quorum requirements vary by state, but cannot be less than one-third of the board.
